- 3. Minutes and matters arising from previous meeting 16th January 2025

- 2. Events full programme confirmed for "Gaelic in Strathnairn Building Connections / Gàidhlig ann an Srath Naruinn Ceanglaichean gun Chrìch" events during Seachdain na Gàidhlig / Gaelic Week. All events in Farr Hall, Monday 24th February to Saturday 1st March. Posts on Facebook and other media. All funded directly through the Seachdain na Gàidhlig grant. Ongoing activities funded through Bòrd na Gàidhlig community grant included well attended public talk by Ruairidh (Roddy) MacLean on "Eadar Srath is Monadh / Between Strath and Upland. Some reflections on the Gaelic place-name heritage of Strathnairn", and Beginners' Gaelic class. Board agreed to prioritise SDC run events for the community. Farr Gala would need funding support from SCBF and residents' volunteer committee being established would address that themselves. Board agreed to support a concert of traditional music being organised by Raghnaid in April, with a budget request to follow.
